- Supporting public awareness campaigns, like SAMHSA's 988 Day and recognizing other mental health awareness campaigns
- Helping increase 988 signage in key touchpoint areas like high risk areas (near bridges, bodies of water, gun stores and shows, etc.) and mental healthcare providers (mental health clinics, hospitals)
